<u>VETERANS CORNER:</u> We are going to try something new and provide information to veterans on various programs and benefits that you have earned and are possibly missing out on.

April's program of interest is: "Presumed exposure to AGENT ORANGE"

The "Agent Orange" program is for any veteran that served IN Viet Nam, meaning (on the land). If you are a veteran who served IN Viet Nam and have not registered with the "Agent Orange" program, it is in your best interest to do so. There are 15 different diseases or medical conditions that are related to the "Presumed Exposure" to Agent Orange.

To get registered into the Agent Orange Program, you will need a copy of your DD-214 which shows that you were physically on land in Viet Nam. Also, any medical records that you have for any treatment or conditions that you have been treated for since being discharged from the military.

Then take your records to your County Veterans Service Officer in the county that you live and ask to register with the Agent Orange Program. You may qualify for many benefits that you weren't aware of.

Just remember, You earned these benefits, don't lose them.
